The out of the ordinary is right under your nose

This ancient land is a palimpsest of tracks written by paw, claw and hoof. Swallows and swifts weave the clear air into pathways as they swoop and soar as intricate as Celtic knots and larks gild it with song. We have stitched a new track trodden by shoe and boot and conjured from song and story, music and memory, film and thought, it is marked by runes. Walk it in silence, listen with the ears of an owl, see with hawk sharp eyes. Walk it as a charm, a summoning to fox, owl, snail and wild flower, all those outlawed by a human fear of the wild. **One for the Rook**

is a call to arms to remember we humans are but a part of life on Earth.

One for the Rook is an acknowledgement and celebration of the wild world around us, the creatures, plants and insects, which are our 'neighbours'. We follow in the footsteps of those beautiful and influential books, *Lost Words* and *Lost Spells* written by Robert Macfarlane and illustrated by Jackie Morris. Although 'following' it is very much our own pathway we have created. The **One for the Rook** trail is quiet, contemplative and can be walked as a meditation. Do come.

One for the Rook is a Bergh Apton Arts (BACAT) production – a linking together of Sculpture Trails for which BACAT achieved wide acclaim and its more recent Dramatic presentations, such as *Songline for Doggerland*, which played to packed houses.
