## THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (YELVERTON, LODDON ROAD) (50MPH SPEED LIMIT) AMENDMENT ORDER 2021

The Norfolk County Council propose to make the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from exceeding 50 miles per hour along the length of road specified in the Schedule below, which is an extension to the existing 50 miles per hour speed limit.

It should be noted that a length of A146 Loddon Road from a point 100m west of its junction with the U78106 Sallow Lane south-eastwards to a point 100m east of its junction with U76508 Slade Lane, is already subject to a speed limit of 50 miles per hour under The Norfolk County Council (Framingham Pigot and Yelverton, Loddon Road) (50 M.P.H Speed Limit) Order 2008. The 2008 Order will be revoked, and the restrictions included in the proposed Order for reasons of clarity and efficient administration of the restriction.
